Scholarship Application Form Instruction Sheet 2024-2025

1. Students must meet all scholarship requirements listed below:
 - ◆ Student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above.
 - ◆ Student must be currently enrolled as a second through fifth year student with at least one full school year remaining until graduation
 - ◆ Student must be full-time status (minimum 12 hours) in an accredited college or university for both fall and spring semesters of the coming year. Scholarships are for one year.
 - ◆ The student must be pursuing a degree in a STEM (science, technology, engineering, or math) major
 - ◆ **To ensure distribution of second semester funding any student awarded a scholarship will be required to mail or email a thank you/appreciation letter to the committee.**
 - ◆ ***Supply and confirm your institutions Financial Aid Office address and contact info. This is critical for distribution of any awarded funds. Complete on application. Please contact your school and verify the correct information.***
2. Read the application form carefully and try to respond fully to all sections. Responses on the application must be typed.
